BACKGROUND NOTES by COLMA

Peter Fitzpatrick and fellow residents were upset (angry even) about the demise of the Lake (part of Claise Brook as it meanders mostly underground (some natural, some in pipes) from its source at Dog Swamp, thru to the Swan River in East Perth) and the adjoining parkland and let both the City of Vincent Mayor Alison Xamon and the Water Corporation know.

- Mayor Xamon recommended they contact UBC to explore establishing a 'friends of group'.
- 1 March: Peter contacted UBC
- 12 March: Grecian & Colma met onsite with Peter and provided advice including <u>UBC' Bushcare Volunteering Guide</u>, this was followed up with a package of information including contact for 'Claise Brook Catchment Group' who used be active here, but now moved to another section of water body near Robertson Park, North Perth.
- 26 April: Christine & Colma joined Peter, local residents and rep from Friends of Lake Monger/Galup for an onsite meeting with Mayor Xamon – who like UBC was every encouraging for a 'friends of group' to be established that would also contribute to the active care and advocacy of the natural area. - 2 June: Interested people met and decided to form a group!

Whilst there is a strong focus on the recreation aspect of the area – it is an important ecological linkage and there is lots of good will.


